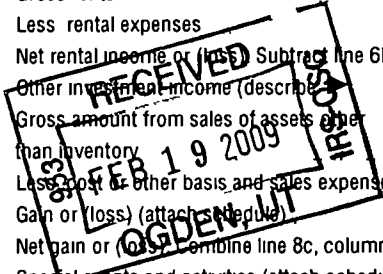

Women Helping Women Services (WHWS) - Works to improve the well being of women and their families throughout the greater Los Angeles area. The majority of clients are single women struggling to raise their families with very limited resources. WHWS operates a volunteer-driven paraprofessional Counseling Talkline, providing individual counseling and support groups and assists clients in addressing problems arising from poverty, domestic violence, depression, unemployment, single parenthood, and child abuse through individualized case management. Counseling services and case management are also provided on a sliding scale for clients. In addition, the program has clothing giveaways and a voucher program for the women and their families.
